Beginning at a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 15 and on the North side of a 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Alala" being 2913.0 feet South and 7652.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2497, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 289° 55' 320.0 feet along road to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. Northerly along the top of the edge of the bluff, the direct azimuth and distance being 190° 29' 1215.0 feet to edge of Waimaaua Gulch;
3. Thence Northwesterly along the top of the pali near the edge of the Waimaaua Gulch, the direct azimuth and distance being 101° 12' 532.1 feet;
4. 360° 00' 1189.0 feet along Lot 15 to the point of beginning.

Area 11-71/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 15 feet wide across this lot for the flume.
