
Lepoloo-Kauniho Homesteads,
North Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe at the East corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 15 and on the North side of Lepoloo Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Honohina^(Old)" being 3711.0 feet South and 664.1 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2588, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 60° 30' 1313.7 along North side of Lepoloo Road to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 150° 30' 486.9 feet along Lot 17 to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 236° 12' 1418.6 feet along Lot 7 of Opea-Peleau Homesteads and Grant 6007 to M. K. Kauhi to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 340° 09' 601.8 feet along Lot 15 to the point of beginning.

Area 16-85/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide for the road across this lot, said right-of-way containing an area of 0.14 acre. Also excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide for the ditch across this lot, said right-of-way containing an area of 0.12 acres, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 16-59/100 ACRES.
