Revised Description.

Lot 17.

Hakalau Homesteads,
S. Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at an iron rail at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 16 and on the South side of 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 18645.8 feet North and 7728.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2574, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 326° 52' 617.0 feet along Lot 16 across a stream to an iron rail on the North side of Grant 1043 to Kapou & Samuela;
2. 52° 25' 661.5 feet along Grant 1043 to Kapou & Samuela to an iron rail on the East side of 40 foot road;
3. 146° 00' 678.0 feet along East side of 40 foot road to an iron rail;
4. 237° 42' 670.0 feet along South side of 40 foot road to the point of beginning.
