Beginning at a pipe at the Southeast corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 17 and on the North side of homestead road, the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahiha" being: 1649.8 feet North and 2101.9 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2498, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $114^{\circ} 06' 30''$  253.5 feet along North side of homestead road to a pipe;
2.  $85^{\circ} 23'$  297.4 feet along North side of homestead road to a pipe;
3.  $167^{\circ} 59'$  926.1 feet along East side of homestead road to a post 10 feet from the edge of a stream ;
4. Easterly along a line parallel to and 10 feet from the edge of the stream to a post, the direct azimuth and distance being:  $257^{\circ} 08' 512.4$  feet;
5.  $348^{\circ} 37'$  1121.7 feet along Lot 17 to the point of beginning.
