Beginning at an iron pipe at the South corner of this lot at the intersection of the boundary of the mauka pasture land with the land of Kamaole, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Kali" being 13510.2 feet South and 13631.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2494, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 114° 35' 1303.0 feet along the land of Kamaole to a mamane post;
2. 215° 29' 1004.1 feet along Lot 38 to a mamane post on the West side of Polipoli road;
3. 309° 46' 1332.3 feet along Polipoli road to a mamane post;
4. 39° 46' 660.0 feet along the mauka pasture lands to the point of beginning.
