Beginning at the Northeast corner of this lot, the true azimuth and distance from "Reference Point" being: $94^{\circ} 55'$ 1007 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 1878, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $15^{\circ} 16'$ 818 feet along Lot 18, now Grant 4457 to H. A. Swift, and road;

2. Thence along North side of 50 foot road to the Southeast corner of Lot 18B, the direct azimuth and distance being: $128^{\circ} 25'$ 923 feet;

3. $195^{\circ} 16'$ 300 feet along Lot 18B;

4. $274^{\circ} 55'$ 863 feet along Ahualoa Homesteads, Homestead Map No. 18, to the point of beginning.
