Beginning at an angle iron and ahu at the North corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 20 and on the West side of West Road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kamakamaka" being: 3505.2 feet North and 7895.0 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2441, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 315° 53' 30" 637.2 feet along West Road to an angle iron and ahu
2. 61° 44' 30" 123.6 feet along <sup>South</sup> ~~North~~ Road to an angle iron and ahu
3. 55° 31' 765.3 feet along <sup>South</sup> ~~North~~ Road; to center of flume;
4. 139° 33' 170.5 feet along center of flume;
5. 124° 42' 30" 1102.2 feet along center of flume;
6. 107° 48' 61.7 feet along center of flume;
7. 93° 05' 119.7 feet along center of flume;
8. 117° 41' 30" 125.9 feet along center of flume;
9. 229° 03' 1035.2 feet along Lot 20 to the point of beginning.

Area 12-05/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide along the West side of this lot, for the flume, said right-of-way containing an area of 13/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 11-92/100 ACRES.
