Beginning at a post surrounded by three triangular pits (A.B.L. mkd) at the East corner of this lot, from which point "Manowaiopae 2" Trig. Station bears  $196^{\circ} 48'$  196.2 feet, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 2177.9 feet South and 7816.6 feet West of Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloo", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2256, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $28^{\circ} 30'$  70.0 feet along 50 foot road reserve to a post marked XIX-XVIII;
2.  $118^{\circ} 30'$  1180.0 feet along Lot 18 to the top of <sup>Kilau</sup> the bank of ~~Kapili~~ Gulch;
3. Along the top of <sup>Kilau</sup> the bank of ~~Kapili~~ Gulch, the direct azimuth and distance being:-  $210^{\circ} 45'$  970.9 feet to a post;
4.  $336^{\circ} 45'$  1454.2 feet along the Government Land to the point of beginning.
