Beginning at a post at the ~~E a s t~~ corner of this lot at a point adjoining the road reserve, the coordinates of which point being: 7724.1 feet South and 9918.1 feet West of the Government Survey Trig. Station "Honohina", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2381, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $69^{\circ} 04'$ 166.8 feet along road reserve;
2. $64^{\circ} 00'$ 948.5 feet along road reserve to the line of the Government Forest Reservation;
3. $157^{\circ} 46'$ 2212.0 feet along the Government Forest Reservation to a boulder marked XIX in Honohina Stream
4. Along the Honohina Stream to boulder marked XIX, the direct azimuth and distance being: $256^{\circ} 05'$ 980.0 feet;
5. $333^{\circ} 40'$ 2017.0 feet along Lot 18 to the point of beginning.
