Beginning at a "W" on a set stone at the Northwest corner of this lot and the East corner of Lot 20 and on the South side of the road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu o Koha" being 5454.4 feet South and 2423.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2391, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 285° 16' 48.7 feet along the road to a + on a set stone;
2. 323° 26' 1198.0 feet along Lot 18 to a + on a solid rock (Monsarrat)
3. 38° 12' 1411.0 feet along L.C.A. 281B to Ali to the middle of the Pulehunui Gulch passing over a + on a solid rock at the end of wall on the North bank of said gulch;
4. Thence down along the middle of the Pulehunui gulch, the direct azimuth and distance being 114° 04' 1484.0 feet;
5. 224° 45' 2083.0 feet along Lot 20 to the point of beginning passing over a + on set stone on the North bank of said gulch at 55.0 feet.
