true azimuths:-

1. 335° 30' 131 feet along L.C.A. 277 to W.C.Lunalilo;
2. 349° 40' 103 feet along L.C.A. 395 to Kahikona;

4. 151° 50' 238 feet along Main Street;
5. 244° 20' 241 feet along Jail Street to the initial point.
