Beginning at a + on stone at the South corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 24 and on the East side of road, the direct azimuth and distance to Trig. Station "Hilo 2" being $152^{\circ} 27' 30''$ 2836.5 feet, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kapuna" are 291.5 feet South and 8107.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2340, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $147^{\circ} 05'$ 722.5 feet along road to a + on set stone;
2. $101^{\circ} 40'$ 880.7 feet along road to a + on solid stone;
3. $158^{\circ} 00'$ 69.7 feet along road to a + on set stone;
4. $192^{\circ} 45'$ 330.0 feet along road to a W on set stone;
5. $194^{\circ} 41'$ 1775.0 feet along Lot 19 to a + on set stone; *See map of Lot 19*
6. $301^{\circ} 22'$ 1031.5 feet along the land of Kioloku to a + on set stone
7. $298^{\circ} 11'$ 440.0 feet along the land of Kioloku to a + on set stone
8. $13^{\circ} 24'$ 2204.0 feet along Lot 24 to the point of beginning.

Area 66-14/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom L.C.A. 9661 to Kauinui and a 20 foot road to same, containing an area of 5-22/100 acres; also excepting and reserving therefrom that portion of the 25 foot roads within this lot, containing an area of 1-04/100 acre; LEAVING A NET AREA OF 59-88/100 ACRES.

Also excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way across this lot for the flume.
