KAUPAKUEA HOMESTEADS,
South Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at a pipe at the South corner of the lot, on the East side of a 30 foot Homestead Road and on boundary of the land of Kahua II, co-ordinates of said point of beginning being 857.9 feet North and 9405.3 feet East of Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2546, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 126° 24' 197.5 feet along 30 foot Homestead Road to a pipe;
2. 180° 05' 52.0 feet along 30 foot Homestead Road to a pipe;
3. 262° 25' 104.3 feet along 30 foot Homestead Road to a pipe;
4. 234° 05' 63.8 feet along 30 foot Homestead Road to a pipe;
5. 220° 55' 142.2 feet along 30 foot Homestead Road to a pipe;
6. 181° 22' 334.6 feet along 30 foot Homestead Road to a pipe;
7. 177° 52' 93.3 feet along 30 foot Homestead Road to a pipe; across
Makea Gulch;
8. Thence along middle of Makea Gulch and boundary of Grant 872 to Emma
Metcalf to a pipe, the direct azimuth and distance
being 268° 19' 1073.6 feet;
9. Thence along same to a + on rock, the direct azimuth and distance
being 340° 56' 378.1 feet;

10. 71° 34' 30" 1360.8 feet along boundary of the land of Kahua II to the point of beginning.
