KIOLAKAA-KEAA HOMESTEAD LOTS.

KAU, HAWAII.

Lot 20.

Beginning at triangle mark and ahu on rock at Puu-makaa 114 feet mauka of middle of Government road at a point whose coordinates referred to Akihi Trig. Station are 11323. feet S. and 15284. feet E. and from which Lolena-nui Trig. Station bears N 38° 31' 30" E true, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running as follows by true bearings; all points being marked by + on stone and ahu, except as otherwise described:-

1. N 8° 26' W 1480 feet along Lot 26;
2. N 63° 57' E 670 feet along Lot 21;
3. S 24° 22' E 1790 feet along Lot 19 and crossing Government road to a point 5 feet mauka of stone wall;
4. S 76° 8' W 1134 feet along Grant 2787, W.C. Shipman, Lot 2, to a point 2-1/2 feet mauka of the middle of stone wall;
5. N 8° 26' W 145 feet crossing Government road and along Lot 26 to the initial point and containing an area of 33-3/10 Acres

Exclusive of a Government reservation, 60 feet wide, through which the Government road passes.
