Beginning at a \dagger on rock, covered by an ahu, at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 21, and on the West side of an Eighty Foot Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kamaole" being 1689.2 feet North and 932.7 feet East, and from said station the true azimuth and distance to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu o Kali" is $264^{\circ} 25'$ 21260.6 feet and to "Puu Io" is $310^{\circ} 32'$ 29400.1 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2237, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $102^{\circ} 10'$ 1290.0 feet along Lot 21 to \dagger on rock and ahu;
- 2a. $203^{\circ} 16'$ 256.0 feet along Lot 20A to \dagger on rock and ahu;
3. $169^{\circ} 55'$ 855.0 feet along Lot 20A to \dagger on rock and ahu;
4. $77^{\circ} 28'$ 484.0 feet along Lot 20A to \dagger on fence post;
5. $150^{\circ} 56'$ 377.0 feet along Grant 3448B to Beniamina Kamaukoli to \dagger on rock and ahu;
6. $125^{\circ} 15'$ 365.0 feet along Grant 3448B to Beniamina Kamaukoli;
7. $132^{\circ} 00'$ 210.0 feet along Grant 3448B to Beniamina Kamaukoli;
8. $77^{\circ} 30'$ 163.0 feet along Grant 3448B to Beniamina Kamaukoli to \dagger on fence post;
9. $151^{\circ} 30'$ 208.0 feet along fence along the road to Kihei;
