1. 360° 00' 766.1 feet along Lots 24, 23 and 22 to a + on stone;
2. 88° 26' 75.4 feet along Government Road to a + on stone;
3. 97° 51' 150.7 feet along Government Road to a + on stone;
4. 126° 28' 115.6 feet along Government Road to a + on stone;
5. 180° 00' 499.3 feet along Lot 20 to a + on stone;
6. 240° 32' 365.2 feet along Homestead Road to the point of beginning.
