Beginning at a \perp on rock, covered by an ahu, at the South-west corner of this lot and on the North side of an Eighty Foot Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kamaole" being 920.4 feet North and 400.5 feet West, and from said station the true azimuth and distance to "Puu-o-Kali" Trig. Station is $264^{\circ} 25'$ 21260.6 feet, and to "Puu Io" Trig. Station is $310^{\circ} 32'$ 29400.1 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2237, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $134^{\circ} 00'$ 1018.0 feet along Government Beach Reservation;
2. $282^{\circ} 40'$ 484.0 feet along Lot 20A to \perp on rock and ahu;
3. $175^{\circ} 31'$ 485.0 feet along Lot 20A to \perp on rock and ahu;
4. $198^{\circ} 10'$ 165.0 feet along Lot 20A to \perp on rock and ahu;
5. $302^{\circ} 18'$ 377.5 feet along Lot 20A to \perp on rock and ahu;
6. $282^{\circ} 10'$ 1290.0 feet along Lot 20 to \perp on rock and ahu;
7. $318^{\circ} 15'$ 257.0 feet along West side of 80 Foot Road;
8. $314^{\circ} 25'$ 1000.0 feet along West side of 80 Foot Road to \perp on rock and ahu;
9. $84^{\circ} 22'$ 334.0 feet along North side of Main 80 Foot Road;

- 10. 99° 57' 624.5 feet along North side of Main 80 Foot Road;
- 11. 92° 09' 1272.0 feet along North side of Main 80 Foot Road to the point of beginning.
