Beginning at a galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 21B, and on the North boundary of Lot 20, (Government Remnants), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Transit of Venus" being ^{1840.4} 1856.3 feet North and ^{2134.5} 2117.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2596, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 213° 56' 40.8 feet along Lot 21B, (Government Remnants);
2. 303° 32' 134.4 feet along Apana 1, of land deeded by Kamehameha III, to M. P. Whitney;
3. 13° 28' 44.3 feet to an iron pipe;
4. 123° 56' 150.0 feet along Lot 20, (Government Remnants), to the point of beginning.
