Beginning at a pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot, at a corner of Lot 23 and on the North side of homestead road, the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahi-ha" being: 2312.5 feet North and 5794.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2498, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 253° 41' 1064.8 feet along Lot 23 and across a stream to a post;
2. 357° 33' 909.2 feet along Lot 21 and across three streams to a pipe on the North side of homestead road;
3. 80° 17' 218.6 feet along North side of homestead road to a pipe;
4. 161° 25' 177.2 feet along East side of homestead road to a pipe;
5. 119° 41' 274.2 feet along Northeast side of homestead road and across a small stream to a pipe;
6. 96° 40' 325.5 feet along Northeast side of homestead road to a pipe;
7. 84° 05' 145.3 feet along North side of homestead road to a pipe;
8. 177° 43' 76.4 feet along East side of homestead road across a small stream to a pipe;
9. 200° 08' 84.0 feet along East side of homestead road to a pipe;
10. 147° 10' 197.4 feet along East side of homestead road to the point of beginning.
