Beginning at a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galvanized iron pipe at the East corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 203, on the West side of Hundley Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Nonou" being 9823.4 feet North and 13773.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2583, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $9^{\circ} 24'$  613.6 feet along Hundley Road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galvanized iron pipe;
2.  $109^{\circ} 49'$  913.4 feet along Lot 230 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galv. iron pipe;
3.  $109^{\circ} 30'$  480.6 feet along Lot 231 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galv. iron pipe;
4.  $228^{\circ} 13'$  158.8 feet along Hauaala Road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galv. iron pipe;
5.  $204^{\circ} 51'$  335.6 feet along Hauaala Road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galv. iron pipe;
6.  $208^{\circ} 26'$  222.8 feet along Hauaala Road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galv. iron pipe;
7.  $294^{\circ} 14'$  1148.2 feet along Lot 203 to the point of beginning.

Area  $18-57/100$  Acres.

1. Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide for the county pipe line across this lot; said right-of-way containing an area of  $8/100$  acre;
2. Also excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way  $20/100$  feet wide for the railroad across this lot; said right-of-way containing an area of  $30/100$  acre; LEAVING A NET AREA OF  $18-19/100$  ACRES.
