Beginning at a pipe at a corner of this lot and the West corner of Lot 22 and at an angle in the homestead road, the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahiha" being: 2312.5 feet North and 5794.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2498, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 80° 30' 171.6 feet along North side of homestead road to a pipe;
2. 121° 29' 68.9 feet along homestead road to a pipe;
3. 184° 22' 263.4 feet along homestead road to a pipe;
4. 134° 53' 86.9 feet along homestead road to a pipe;
5. 99° 40' 77.9 feet along homestead road to a pipe;
6. 184° 31' 123.9 feet along homestead road and across a stream to a pipe;
7. 168° 20' 113.1 feet along homestead road to a pipe;
8. 148° 41' 115.5 feet along homestead road to a pipe;
9. 169° 42' 120.2 feet along homestead road to a pipe 10 feet from edge of a stream;
10. Easterly along a line parallel to and 10 feet from edge of the stream to a post, the direct azimuth and distance being: 278° 29' 1466.8 feet;
11. 357° 33' 280.8 feet along Lot 21 to a post;
12. 73° 41' 1064.8 feet along Lot 22 and across a stream to the point of beginning.
