Beginning at a post marked XXII at the North corner of this lot and at the West bank of a small gulch at the road reserve, the coordinates of which point are 4997.0 feet South and 7492.4 feet West of Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloo", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2256, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 310° 30' 811.7 feet along 50 foot read reserve;
2. 28° 30' 1960.0 feet along Lot 24;
3. 118° 30' 461.2 feet along Government land to the East bank of a small gulch;
4. 244° 20' 384.0 feet along the Southeast bank of said gulch;
5. Along the East bank of said gulch, the direct azimuth and distance being: 188° 00' 1406.0 feet;
6. Continuing along the East bank of said gulch, the direct azimuth and distance being: 201° 30' 506.0 feet to the point of beginning.
