Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized pipe at the Southeast corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 1 and on the West bank of the Hanalei River, Government Survey Trig. Station "Paina" is by true azimuth and distance $38^{\circ} 15'$ 1807.0 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2262, and running by true azimuths:

1. $98^{\circ} 44'$ 144.3 feet along Lot 1;
2. $16^{\circ} 05'$ 66.0 feet along Lot 1;
3. $106^{\circ} 33'$ 52.5 feet along Lot 1;
4. $184^{\circ} 33'$ 139.2 feet along Lot 1;
5. $90^{\circ} 19'$ 422.3 feet along Lot 1 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized pipe;
6. $180^{\circ} 00'$ 230.4 feet along Lots 33 and 34;
7. $270^{\circ} 00'$ 582.1 feet along Lots 25 and 24;
8. $283^{\circ} 48'$ 119.3 feet along Lot 24 to a redwood post;
9. $10^{\circ} 04'$ 135.8 feet along the Hanalei River;
10. $15^{\circ} 48'$ 189.8 feet along the Hanalei River to the point of beginning.
