## KIOLAKAA-KEAA HOMESTEAD LOTS.

KAU, HAWAII.

Lot 23.

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot 22 at + on stone and ahu in a small grassy hollow at a point whose coordinates referred to Akihi Trig. Station are 8156.1 feet S. and 12379.3 feet E. and from which Kajuapuhi Trig. Station bears S 28° 55' W true, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running as follows by true bearings; all points being marked by + on stone and ahu;-

1. N 80° 18' E 2312 feet along Lot 22; *and Lot 21A*
2. S 40° 30' W 1432 feet along Government reservation for 40 foot road, to + on pahoehoe and ahu;
3. S 81° 10' W 1317 feet along Lot 24;
4. N 3° 10' W 910 feet along Lot 7 to the initial point and containing an area of 38-2/10 Acres.
