Station "Launiupoko" being North 10436 feet and West 14270 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 1193, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $334^{\circ} 30'$ 264 feet along Main Street;
2. $64^{\circ} 55'$ 275 feet along the land of Waiokama to the sea;
3. $144^{\circ} 20'$ 253 feet along the sea;
4. $242^{\circ} 10'$ 320 feet along Lot 22 to the initial point.
