5. 105° 19' 212.0 feet along road to a + cut on stone;
6. 192° 05' 30" 412.5 feet along Lot 24 to a + cut on stone;
7. 269° 00' 394.2 feet along Grant 2680 apana 2, to Kahua to a + cut on stone
8. 271° 30' 173.0 feet along Grant 2941 to Kaianui and Kaloi to a + cut on stone on bluff;
9. 259° 15' 215.0 feet along Grant 2941 to Kaianui and Kaloi to a + cut on stone;
10. 4° 55' 30" 313.4 feet along L.C.A. 4855 to Ikoa to a + cut on stone;
11. 292° 35' 231.0 feet along L.C.A. 4855 to Ikoa to a + cut on stone
12. 250° 50' 160.5 feet along L.C.A. 4855 to Ikoa to the point of beginning.
