Station "Puu-o-Hewa" being: 1.2 feet South and 3910.8 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2492, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 263° 18' 480.7 feet along Lot 8 to a + on stone;
2. 17° 34' 30" 363.5 feet along the Omao Reservoir Reserve to a + on stone;
3. 63° 10' 220.2 feet along the Omao Reservoir Reserve to a + on stone;
4. 353° 44' 571.5 feet along the Omao Reservoir Reserve to a + on stone;
5. 55° 25' 30" 82.74 feet along Lot 41 to a + on stone;
6. 147° 03' 414.8 feet along Main 30 Foot Road;
7. 175° 36' 207.2 feet along the Kauai Railroad 40 foot right-of-way
8. 189° 43' 452.0 feet along the Kauai Railroad 40 foot right-of-way to the point of beginning.
