Station "Kaholo" being 11327.4 feet South and 6301.5 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2311, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 159° 40' 269.0 feet up West bank of gulch to post \triangle at angle of road;
2. 75° 40' 162.0 feet along road to post \triangle ;
3. 53° 36' 83.0 feet along road to post \triangle ;
4. 129° 13' 129.0 feet along road to post \triangle ;
5. 77° 31' 73.0 feet along road to post \triangle ;
6. 12° 14' 92.0 feet along road to post \triangle ; ;
7. 46° 54' 209.0 feet along road to post \triangle ;
8. 53° 37' 185.0 feet along road to post \triangle ;
9. 26° 45' 26.0 feet along road to post \triangle ;
10. 113° 10' 358.0 feet along Government land to a point on the Kaala-Kealakaha boundary;
11. 192° 33' 1526.0 feet along the land of Kaala;
12. 292° 40' 1330.0 feet along Grant 4575 to Geo. Osborne to a point in middle of Kealakaha Gulch;

13. 22° 45' 1070.0 feet along the middle of the gulch to the point
• of beginning.
