Beginning at a pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 26 and on the North side of homestead road, the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahiha" being: 2565.0 feet North and 7517.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2498, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 175° 20' 269.3 feet along Lot 26 across a stream to a pipe;
2. 267° 56' 1369.7 feet along Lot 25 to a pipe on the West side of homestead road;
3. 347° 29' 98.7 feet along West side of homestead road to a pipe;
4. 2° 00' 148.0 feet along West side of homestead road and across a stream to a pipe;
5. 279° 40' 85.0 feet along South side of homestead road to a pipe;
6. 315° 22' 66.4 feet along West side of homestead road to a pipe;
7. 4° 18' 264.1 feet along West side of homestead road to a pipe;
8. 313° 46' 42.5 feet along West side of homestead road to a pipe on the North side of a homestead road;
9. 78° 01' 219.1 feet along North side of homestead road to a pipe;
10. 88° 59' 427.0 feet along North side of homestead road to a pipe;
11. 101° 15' 506.4 feet along North side of homestead road to a pipe;
12. 123° 00' 434.5 feet along North side of homestead road to the point of beginning.
