Beginning at a 2-1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot the North corner of Lot 25, on the Southeast side of a 30 foot Homestead Road, the co-ordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Manowaiopae 3" being 349.2 feet North and 3642.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2555, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 234° 21' 111.4 feet along the Southeast side of Homestead Road;
2. 231° 33' 162.7 feet along the Southeast side of Homestead Road to a 2-1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 298° 35' 187.9 feet along the South side of Homestead Road to a 2-1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 28° 35' 250.0 feet along Lot 23 to a 2-1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 118° 35' 299.8 feet along Lot 25 to the point of beginning.
