Beginning at a post marked XXV-XXIV at the North corner of this lot and the road reserve, the coordinates of which point are 5843.1 feet South and 6501.3 feet West of Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloo", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2256, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $310^{\circ} 30'$  1415.0 feet along 50 foot road reserve to a post marked XXV at the North edge of Kaiwilahilahi Gulch;
2. Along the North edge of said gulch, the direct azimuth and distance being:  $69^{\circ} 55'$  2090.0 feet to a post ~~the~~ the South corner of Lot 24;
3.  $208^{\circ} 30'$  1859.6 feet along Lot 24 to the point of beginning.
