Lot 25.  
Waiohuli-Keokea Homesteads,  
Kula, Maui.

Beginning at a mamane post at the East corner of this lot and the South corner of Lot 24 on the West side of Waiohuli road, *10' wide* the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Kali" being: 6882.2 feet South and 16639.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2494, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 24° 22' 314.0 feet along Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
2. 23° 13' 415.0 feet along ~~Waiohuli road~~ *road* to a mamane post on the North side of ~~road~~ *road*; *10 ft wide*
3. 129° 46' 1208.0 feet along ~~the road~~ *road* to a mamane post on the East side of Polipoli road; *40 ft wide*
4. 202° 50' 227.0 feet along ~~Polipoli road~~ *road* across the Kula Pipe Line right-of-way to a mamane post;
5. 206° 34' 261.5 feet along ~~Polipoli road~~ *road* to a mamane post; *6 ft wide*
6. 206° 14' 236.2 feet along ~~Polipoli road~~ *road* to a mamane post;
7. 309° 46' 1191.0 feet along Lot 24 across the Kula Pipe Line right-of-way to the point of beginning.

Area 19-37/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 6 feet wide for the ~~Kula Pipe Line~~ across this lot, said right-of-way containing an area of 8/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 19-29/100 ACRES.
