LOTS 26, 27 and 28, BLOCK B

Piihonua, South Hilo, Hawaii, T. H.

Lots 26 and 27 being portions of the Government (Crown) Land of Piihonua and Lot 28 being Grant 4632 to Harriet F. Coan, conveyed to the Territory of Hawaii by Hilo Tribune-Herald, Limited, by deed dated July 23, 1949 and recorded in Liber 2245, Pages 425-429 (Land Office Deed 8820).

Beginning at the east corner of Lot 26, the south corner of Hilo Armory Site (Executive Order 192) and on the northwest side of Shipman Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "HALAI" being 3676.86 feet North and 2921.03 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2544, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 56° 48' 104.49 feet along the northwest side of Shipman Street;
2. 148° 55' 126.09 feet along the northeast side of Keawe Street;
3. 236° 48' 99.83 feet along the southeast side of Wailuku Street;
4. 326° 48' 126.00 feet along Hilo Armory Site (Executive Order 192) to the point of beginning and containing an Area of 12,871 Square Feet.
