Beginning at a 2" inch iron pipe at the South corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 27 and on the West side of Koae Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Nonou" being 9984.1 feet North and 12944.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2613, and running by ~~true azimuths~~ *measured clockwise from TRUE South*:-

1. 126° 00' 342.7 feet along Lot 27 to an iron pipe;
2. 208° 26' 151.4 feet along the East side of Hauaaala Road to an iron pipe;
3. 306° 00' 362.7 feet along Lot 25 to an iron pipe;
4. 36° 00' 150.0 feet along the West side of Koae Road to the point of beginning.

Area 1-22/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide for ditch (Area 04/100 Acre), and a right-of-way 20 feet wide for railroad (Area 07/100 Acre), across this lot, as shown on plan hereto attached and made a part hereof, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 1-11/100 ACRES.
