1. $53^{\circ} 10'$ 141 feet along L.C.A. 3834 to Puhi;
2. $140^{\circ} 10'$ 248 feet along the sea;
3. $234^{\circ} 10'$ 155 feet along L.C.A. 83 to Thos. Philips;
4. $323^{\circ} 20'$ 245 feet along Main Street to the initial point.
