Beginning at the Northeast corner of this lot and the East corner of Lot 25A and on the West side of road (80 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kamaole" being 2791.1 feet South and 3496.8 feet East, and from said station the true azimuth and distance to "Puu-o-Kali" Trig. Station is 264° 25' 21260.6 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2237, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 349° 25' 750.0 feet along road;
2. 92° 36' 1610.5 feet along Lot 27A;
3. 164° 40' 767.0 feet along Lot 26B;
4. 272° 35' 1675.5 feet along Lot 25A to the point of beginning.
