4. 183° 37' 190.0 feet along Polipoli road to a mamane post;
5. 185° 17' 300.0 feet along Polipoli road to a mamane post;
6. 205° 26' 81.5 feet along Polipoli road to a mamane post;
7. 170° 16' 15.0 feet along Polipoli road to a mamane post;
8. 309° 46' 1040.0 feet along Lot 26 to a mamane post on the West side of Waiohuli road;
9. 39° 16' 150.0 feet along Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
10. 22° 02' 231.9 feet along Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
11. 28° 30' 131.0 feet along Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
12. 20° 25' 200.0 feet along Waiohuli road to the point of beginning.
