KIOLAKAA-KEAA HOMESTEAD LOTS.

KAU, HAWAII.

Lot 27.

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot 28 at + on stone and ahu 1002 feet mauka of middle of Government road at a point whose coordinates referred to Akihi Trig. Station are 10382.3 feet S. and 4586.5 feet E. and from which Ka-lua-olai Trig. Station bears S 67° 58' W true, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running as follows by true bearings; all points being marked by + on stone and ahu, unless otherwise described:-

1. S 3° 19' E 356 feet along Government reservation for 40 foot road;
2. S 6° 20' E 387 feet along the same;
3. S 70° 7' W 555 feet along Government reservation to triangle on stone and ahu;
4. S 37° 14' W 55.7 feet along the same to an unmarked point; thence along the Government reservation, 60 feet wide, through which the Government road passes to a point

6. N 2° 20' W 772 feet along Lot 32; *(Grant 5456 to Tom Kamalii)*
7. N 88° 55' E 1846 feet along Lot 28 ^{*(Grant 8464 to Y.P. Nakai)*} to the initial point and containing

an area of 32-1/10 Acres.
