Beginning at an iron pipe at the West corner of this lot and on the South side of Homestead Road (40 feet wide), the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 15677.9 feet North and 9548.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2382., and running by true azimuths:-

1. $313^{\circ} 20'$ 1385.0 feet along Lot 29 to the middle of Kolekole Gulch passing over a post at 1150.0 feet on the North edge of said gulch;
2. Thence down the middle of Kolekole Gulch, the direct azimuth and distance to the South corner of Lot 27 being: $206^{\circ} 32'$ 1176.0 feet;
3. $134^{\circ} 15'$ 490.0 feet along Lot 27 to an iron pipe at the West corner of said lot passing over a post at 275.0 feet on the North edge of Kolekole Gulch;
4. $67^{\circ} 04'$ 357.5 feet along Homestead Road (40 feet wide) to an iron pipe;
5. $70^{\circ} 16'$ 907.0 feet along Homestead Road (40 feet wide) to the point of beginning.
