Beginning at the Northeast corner of Eastern abutment of Makapipi Bridge, which point is N 42° 00' W true, 175 feet from Trig. Station "Apana", as shown on Public Land Map No. 20, Reg. No. 51, and running by true azimuths:-

1. Down the center of Makapipi Stream, direct azimuth and distance being:

193° 00' 2413.0 feet;

2. 298° 45' 2350.0 feet to the middle of Kuhiwa Gulch; an ohia post on the banks of both gulches marking the makai boundary;

3. Up Kuhiwa Gulch, center being the boundary, to the main Government Road, direct azimuth and distance being:

49° 15' 2575.0 feet;

4. Along Government Road, 25 feet makai of center line of same, to the initial point; direct azimuth and distance being: 125° 00' 800.0 feet, and containing an area of 89.60 acres.
