Revised Description.

Lot 30.

Kuiaha-Kaupakulua Homesteads,
Hamakualoa, Maui.

Beginning at an iron rail at the Southwest corner of this lot and on the East side of Huelo-Paia Government Road, the coordinates of said iron rail referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauhikoa" being 8993.5 feet North and 6552.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2542, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 163° 17' 250.3 feet along Huelo-Paia Government Road;
2. 254° 57' 96.9 feet along Lot 10 Kuiaha-Pauwela Homesteads;
3. 188° 30' 570.0 feet along Lot 10 Kuiaha-Pauwela Homesteads;
4. 235° 32' 1028.6 feet along Lot 29 crossing Kolealea Gulch to the East side of a 40 foot road;
5. Thence along the East side of said 40 foot road on a curve to the right with a radius of 266.6 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being: 217° 24' 198.3 feet;
6. 346° 32' 1421.1 feet along Homestead Road and Lot 34, Kuiaha-Kaupakulua Homesteads;
7. 82° 27' 1417.6 feet along Lot 31, Kuiaha-Kaupakulua Homesteads crossing Kolealea Gulch to the point of beginning.

Area 31-19/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom Kolealea Stream and all riparian and other rights in or to this stream and the waters thereof.

Also Excepting and reserving therefrom a strip of land

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forty feet wide across this lot for a public road, as shown on the plan made a part hereof, said road strip containing an area of 2.07 acres, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 29-12/100 ACRES.
