Revised Description.

Lot 32.

Hakalau Homesteads,
Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at an iron rail at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 31 and on the South side of Mountain Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 16689.7 feet North and 3515.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2574, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 328° 00' 1390.0 feet along Lots 31 and 35 to an iron rail 10 feet from the edge of the Kaahakini Stream;
2. Along a line parallel to and 10 feet distant from edge of the Kaahakini Stream, the direct azimuth and distance being 57° 31' 448.7 feet to an iron rail.
3. 148° 00' 1359.0 feet along Lots 36 and 33 to an iron rail on the South side of Mountain Road;
4. 239° 45' 57.0 feet along Mountain Road to an iron rail;
5. 231° 20' 329.0 feet along Mountain Road to an iron rail;
6. 239° 25' 65.0 feet along Mountain Road to the point of beginning.

Area 14-16/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide across this lot for the flume, said right-of-way containing an area of 10/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 14-06/100 ACRES.
