Beginning at a redwood post at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 34, Government Survey Trig. Station "Paina" is by true azimuth and distance  $27^{\circ} 48'$  2788.8 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2262, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $163^{\circ} 19'$  142.6 feet along Lot 34;
2.  $155^{\circ} 45'$  172.3 feet along Lot 34;

Thence along trail along Hanalei River, direct azimuth and distance being:

3.  $224^{\circ} 21'$  107.3 feet;
4.  $243^{\circ} 20'$  65.7 feet;
5.  $308^{\circ} 13'$  39.2 feet along hau fence <sup>along</sup> Hanalei River;
6.  $347^{\circ} 25'$  188.5 feet along hau fence <sup>along</sup> Hanalei River;
7.  $344^{\circ} 46'$  129.3 feet along hau fence <sup>along</sup> Hanalei River;
8.  $329^{\circ} 14'$  40.5 feet along hau fence <sup>along</sup> Hanalei River;
9.  $77^{\circ} 48'$  151.8 feet along Lot 32 to the initial point.
