Beginning at + on stone and ahu at the Northeast corner of Grant 1371, W.T.M.Koma, S 53° 47' E true 200 feet from N.E.Koma Trig. Station and triangle mark, said Trig. Station being S 15° 28' 30" E true from Akihi Trig. Station with coordinates 12008.1 feet S. and 3324.5 feet E. from said Akihi, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176 and running as follows by true bearings; all points being marked by + on stone and ahu;

1. S 80° 34' W 1620 feet along Grant 1371, W.T.M.Koma;
