Revised Description.

Lot 33.

Kuiaha-Kaupakulua Homesteads,
Hamakualoa, Maui.

Beginning at the Northwest corner of this lot, on the East side of Homestead Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauhikoa" being 11310.9 feet North and 7488.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2542, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 285° 07' 623.1 feet;
2. 308° 19' 416.3 feet;
3. 331° 17' 280.2 feet;
4. 271° 15' 402.3 feet along the right-of-way for the Kahului Railroad Company to boundary of Ulumalu;
5. 345° 52' 214.0 feet along the land of Ulumalu;
6. 344° 30' 927.3 feet along the land of Ulumalu;
7. 97° 19' 1393.4 feet along Lot 34 Kuiaha-Kaupakulua Homesteads;
8. 166° 32' 1642.2 feet along Homestead road to the point of beginning.

Area 40-90/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 40 feet wide across this lot for the Kahului Railroad, area 1-21/100 acres. Also excepting and reserving therefrom two strips of land, each forty feet wide, across this lot for public roads, as shown on plan and made a part hereof; said road strips containing an area of 2.12 acres; LEAVING A NET AREA OF 37-57/100 ACRES. Also excepting and reserving therefrom the Kauoha Stream and all riparian and other rights in or to said stream and the waters thereof.
