5. 347° 47' 475.2 feet along the land of Ulumalu;
6. 92° 43' 970.8 feet along Lot 35;
7. 146° 00' 340.0 feet along Lot 31;
8. 166° 32' 1242.0 feet along Lots 31 and 30 to the point of beginning.
