Beginning at a + cut on large rock at the South corner of this lot and the West corner of Lot 35 and on the North side of road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puuiki" being 4100.1 feet North and 5236.8 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2547, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $183^{\circ} 42'$ 1411.3 feet along Lot 35 across stream to a + cut on stone;
2. $105^{\circ} 14'$ 400.0 feet along Government Remnant to a + cut on pahoe-hoe;
3. $356^{\circ} 57'$ 799.0 feet along government land to a + cut on stone; on knoll near the edge of the stream;
4. $7^{\circ} 01' 30''$ 289.5 feet across stream along government land to road;
5. $12^{\circ} 10'$ 247.0 feet along East side of road to a + cut on stone;
6. $298^{\circ} 49'$ 388.0 feet along North side of road to the point of beginning.

Excepting and reserving the stream and all riparian and other rights in or to this stream and the waters thereof.
