Beginning at an iron pipe at the West corner of this lot and the South side of Homestead Road (40 feet wide), the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 13440.8 feet North and 4136.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2382, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 329° 40' 2610.0 feet along Lot 37 to the middle of Kolekole Gulch passing over a post at 2360.0 feet on the North edge of said gulch;
2. Thence down the middle of Kolekole Gulch, the direct azimuth and distance to the South corner of Lot 35 being: 242° 51' 348.0 feet;
3. 156° 55' 2470.0 feet along Lot 35 to an iron pipe at the West corner of said lot passing over a post at 250.0 feet on the North edge of Kolekole Gulch;
4. 64° 21' 230.0 feet along Homestead Road (40 feet wide) to an iron pipe;
5. 120° 40' 71.0 feet along Homestead Road (40 feet wide) to an iron pipe;
6. 80° 26' 94.0 feet along Homestead Road (40 feet wide) to an iron pipe;
7. 84° 43' 75.0 feet along Homestead Road (40 feet wide) to an iron pipe;
8. 356° 07' 96.0 feet along Homestead Road (40 feet wide) to an iron pipe;
9. 90° 49' 231.0 feet along Homestead Road (40 feet wide) to the point of beginning.
