Revised Description.

Lot 38.

Hakalau Homesteads,
S. Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at an iron rail at the West corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 39 and on the South side of Mountain Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 15445.0 feet North and 1170.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2574, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 235° 05' 215.0 feet along Mountain Road to an iron rail;
2. 226° 25' 315.0 feet along Mountain Road to an iron rail;
3. 327° 27' 1451.0 feet along Lot 37 to an iron rail;
4. 58° 00' 537.0 feet along Lot 52 to an iron rail;
5. 148° 00' 1377.0 feet along Lot 39 to the point of beginning.

Area 17-09/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide across this lot for the flume, said right-of-way containing an area of 13/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 16-96/100 ACRES.
