2. $302^{\circ} 25'$ 75.2 feet along near bank of Hanalei River;
3. $282^{\circ} 25'$ 205.6 feet along near bank of the Hanalei River and Hoopau Stream;
4. $355^{\circ} 10'$ 101.1 feet along Lot 38;
5. $86^{\circ} 28'$ 127.8 feet along same;
6. $91^{\circ} 47'$ 44.5 feet along same;
7. $161^{\circ} 28'$ 38.2 feet along same;
8. $93^{\circ} 45'$ 66.8 feet along same;
9. $32^{\circ} 35'$ 104.4 feet along same;
10. $61^{\circ} 01'$ 78.1 feet along same;
11. $77^{\circ} 56'$ 523.8 feet along Lots 38 and 36-A to an iron pipe;
